If vacancies reserved for OBC candidates cannot be filled from the Other Backward Classes, then the vacancies so lying unfilled may be filled by persons not belonging to the Other Backward

Age. There shall be no upper age restriction for apprenticeship training as per Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) office memorandum No FNo MSDE-14(03)/2021 AP-(PMU) dated 20 Dec 21 Minimum age is 14 years and for hazardous occupations it is 18 years according to The Apprentice Act 1961 Accordingly, candidates born before June 2010 are eligible for nonhazardous trades and candidates born before June 2008 are eligible for hazardous trades. Candidates are to be aware that there is an age limit set in the recruitment rules for the post of Tradesman Skilled in Naval Dockyard, Mumbai

Minimum Physical Standards, Height 150 cm, Weight not less than 45 Kg. Chest expansion not less than 5 cm. Eye sight 6/6 to 6/9 (6/9 corrected with glasses), external & internal organs to be normal. Physical fitness standards are as per McD letter FM/0442/NHO/1278 D(N-II) dated 14 Nov 1996.

Previous Training. Candidates who have already undergone or are currently undergoing Apprenticeship under the Apprentices Act - 1961 in any Govt Sector/ Private Industrial Organisation are not eligible to apply for the current enrolment
